



All Springfield Catholic High School Students who have taken any business course are eligible to participate in FBLA. FBLA offers students a chance to practice displaying their business skills in professional settings and competitions while providing opportunities to accumulate service hours.

- FBLA students will compete in the District Leadership Competition in February at Missouri State University.
  - Students may choose up to three events to compete in from the Event List
- Qualifying students will compete in the State Leadership Conference in April at Missouri State University.
  - The top performer from DLC events will move on to compete at the state level, or students have the option to compete in a “straight to state” event.
- FBLA students earn service hours through working at the FBLA Cafe before school. Students sign up for a week to work the cafe and provide breakfast beverages to students and staff. Working one week in the FBLA cafe=3.5 service hours.
- FBLA students will also earn service hours through FBLA sponsored community service events. These events will take place throughout the school year and are organized by the Community Service Officer.
- FBLA will host two social events throughout the school year that members are encouraged to attend. The Social Chair organizes the social events, one per semester.
- FBLA dues are \$35. This covers the national and state FBLA dues, contributes to social events and covering the cost of competition for students.
