ASSIGNMENT:

- 1. Find an item from each of the following 6 categories and bring them to class:
 - A. FAMILY

B. PHOTOGRAPH

A photograph that is special to you... your family, you as a baby, you playing a sport, your grandparents, etc.

C. FOOD

A food to represent you... your favorite food, a food that represents your family, or even a food that your really HATE!!!

D. BOOK

A book to represent you... a favorite book, a book written by a family member, a book you've created, a scrapbook, etc.

E. HOMEMADE

Something you've made... a painting, a drawing, a collage, a puppet, a sculpture, article of clothing, jewelry... ANYTHING YOU'VE MADE!

F. GENERAL

An all-around item that represents the whole of you. Be creative!

- 2. Place all items together in a container (shoe box, grocery bag, etc.) and bring them to class on <u>August 18th</u> ready to present.
- 3. Be prepared to talk (show-and-tell) about each item to the class in a 2-4 minute presentation.
